

WATA Assisted Places Scheme

As a Registered Charity with the objective of promoting and providing training for employment, Wata is keen to ensure wide accessibility to its training courses. The Assisted Places Scheme (APS) is designed to ensure that people from all backgrounds and incomes have an opportunity to attend Wata courses.

Discounts for Self-Funders

1. Where an individual is financing the course themselves, they will be eligible for a 20% discount on the full course fee.
2. The individual will be requested to sign a declaration confirming that they are funding the course themselves and will not receive funding from elsewhere.
3. In such cases invoicing will be directly to the individual and sent to their home address.

Free Places

1. Each year there will be one free place available on every type of course offered at our training centre.
2. The applicant must meet any pre-course entry requirements such as qualifications or experience.
3. The applicant must demonstrate that they are unable to afford the course fees. This will include evidence of income from all sources and those with an income exceeding £10,000 per annum are unlikely to be successful on application for a free place.
4. The Applicant is required to provide the following Information:
 - A concise CV detailing personal details including any relevant qualifications.
 - A short statement outlining why the application for a specific course is being made.

- A short statement giving commitment and availability to complete the course and any course related assignments, assessments and examinations.
5. The Scheme is open to UK Residents only.
 6. The company reserves the right to discretion when allocating the free places.
 7. The company reserves the right to remove the student from the course in the event of poor performance, achievement, attendance or behaviour.
 8. The Company reserves the right to modify the terms and conditions of the Assisted Places Scheme at any time and without notice.

Discounts for other Charities

1. A 20% discount shall be given to course bookings from Registered Charities. Evidence of Charitable status may be requested.

Individuals or organisations who are receiving funding for training from government, EU or other sources will not be eligible for the Assisted Places Scheme.
