What does the course cover?

Domestic electrical installers who need to appreciate the requirements that apply to building work they carry out in connection with their electrical work, and who need to understand the way that Building Control works and the procedures that need to be followed.

This one-day course enables practising electricians, operating in the domestic environment, to gain an understanding of how electrical installations in dwellings must comply with all relevant Building Regulations. The qualification does not deal with the technical electrical requirements when carrying out such work.

Exam: A multiple choice online, open book 40 minutes exam will be held separately from the course.
