C I E H Level 3 Award in HACCP in Catering

The WATA route to success

From 11th January 2006, EU legislation required all businesses producing food to have a documented food safety management system in place, based on Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point (HACCP) principles. Although effective in theory, HACCP has been particularly difficult to establish in catering businesses because of the sheer number and variety of processes involved in preparing and serving food. But practical, accessible and user-friendly management tools have been created, notably the *Safer Food Better Business* (SFBB) pack adopted by the FSA, to help caterers comply with the new regulations.

The Chartered Institute of Environmental Health (CIEH) Level 3 Award in HACCP in Catering course examines HACCP and tools such as SFBB and will be invaluable for managers and proprietors of small food businesses across the UK.

This 1 day course will be assessed by successfully completing a HACCP assignment in their workplace which must be submitted for marking.

CIEH now require all delegates to provide photo ID (eg. passport, driving licence, work pass) in order to sit the exam. Delegates who do not produce photo ID will not be allowed to sit the exam.

What does the course cover?

- The 12 steps in the HACCP process
- Controls required to ensure food safety
- Uses of a management tool such as the FSA's *Safer Food Better Business* pack

Who is the course suitable for? This course is suitable for owners and managers of food businesses. It is recommended that delegates have followed the normal route to this course via the Level 2 Food Hygiene Certificate (formerly the Basic) or equivalent, although this is not compulsory
