IEMA Foundation Certificate in Environmental Management / IOSH Managing Environmental Responsibilities Course – 5 Days

The WATA route to success

The IEMA and IOSH accredited training is delivered in conjunction with Cambio.

This is a one-week course designed as an intensive introduction to environmental management for those developing an interest in this subject. Successful delegates will receive the IEMA Foundation Certificate and/or the IOSH Managing Environmental Responsibilities Certificate and may go on to the IEMA Associate Certificate (additional week) or, if criteria are met, the NEBOSH Diploma in Environmental Management.

This course is designed for those with responsibility for implementing requirements of an environmental management practice.

The course assessment involves coursework evaluation, together with a short examination at the end of the course.

What does the course cover?

- Environmental issues
- Introduction to Environmental Law
- Environmental Management and Techniques
- People Skills in Environmental Management

IEMA Foundation Certificate (Certificate fee includes affiliate membership of IEMA) and/or IOSH Managing Environmental Responsibilities Certificate

Who is the course suitable for?

Delegates wishing to take the first step as an environmental management practitioner and who will be responsible for implementing requirements of an environmental management system.
