- Documentation and Implementation Audits.
- Audit programmes & conducting audits.
- Audit Report and follow up actions.
- Behavioural Issues.

Delegates are encouraged to bring examples of their existing OHSMS procedures to the course, which will be used for the preparation of audit check sheets.

Who is the course suitable for?

Suitable for delegates with responsibility for performing occupational health and safety management system audits and for those who require and understanding of the audit process.
