The WATA route to success

A one-day course for those working under an environmental management system, who need to understand how organisations can have an impact on the environment, and what can be done to control these impacts.

What does the course cover?

- Pollution of the air, land, and water
- Overview of environmental law
- Environmental management (Standards, Management Tools, Environmental Risk Assessment)

Assessment is by a short examination at the end of the day and successful delegates will receive an IOSH Certificate.
