What does the course cover?

It covers the practical issues of managing environmental risk. The syllabus takes a risk management approach based on the best practice and international industry standards, including:

- Environmental Management Systems and impact assessments
- Sources and use of energy and energy efficiency
- Control of pollution
- Planning for and dealing with environmental emergencies

Who is the course suitable for?

Managers, supervisors and employees for managing environment issues, as part of their day to day duties. The qualification focuses on UK law and environmental management systems, and leads to a Level 3 Certificate in Environmental Management. It is an excellent starting from which to undertake the NEBOSH Diploma in Environmental Management.

How is the course assessed?

Students are assessed by a written examination and a practical Environmental Review of the student's own workplace which must be returned to WATA within 7 days of the examination.
