## Health and Safety Courses

### Noise at Work Risk Assessment – 5 Days

#### What does the course cover?

A five-day course with a written and practical examination. Successful delegates will receive a WATA Certificate.

The syllabus includes:

- The effect of Noise Induced Deafness
- How the ear works
- Measurement scales and units in noise assessments
- Instrumentation for sound measurement
- Noise survey; sound propagation; sound absorption and sound insulation.
- The Control of Noise at Work Regulations (2005)
- The Noise Management Programme
- Noise control – diagnostics & ranking, mechanical and aerodynamic
- Noise enclosures and noise reductions
- Noise measurement will be carried out in-house and a factory visit, to enable delegates to carry out a noise survey under real conditions.

Throughout the course there will be a number of practical exercises/work and group projects to carry out. There will also be homework, revision and a written and practical examination.

There will be a site visit during the course and delegates are advised to dress appropriately and wear stout/safety shoes. If it is available for the week, please bring the sound level meter you would normally use. Note that you will be able to use one of the latest meters at some stage during the site visit.
