The WATA route to success

The Provision and the Use of Work Equipment Regulations 1998 (PUWER 98), requires that work equipment, including presses, are maintained in an efficient state, efficient working order and in good repair, so far as health and safety is concerned. This means that your employees who maintain your presses must have the necessary knowledge, skill, time and facilities to carry out this duty.

What does the course cover?

The H.S.E. guidelines, rules and laws governing the use of Power Presses

Who is the course suitable for?

Press operators, setters and maintenance personnel.

This course is designed to give delegates the required training to safely use power presses within the legislation set out by the HSE. It covers legal requirements delivered in the training room and is backed up by HSE videos

The practical element covers the necessary checks
