Safe Use of Power Tools – One day

What does the course cover?

This one day course is designed to give delegates a good basis of safety in a large range of power tools. Due to market diversity the course will cover general tools used, although specialist tools can be discussed and even brought to the course, given prior notice.

The syllabus includes:

- The general differences between using electric, battery or pneumatic tools with regard to specific hazards.
- The use of drilling machines, manual and automatic chucks.
- The use of Saws, jig, circular and reciprocating.
- Safety in the choice and changing of blades
- Safety in the use of Grinders, 4", 9" and 12" petrol and bench
- The correct choice of blades and discs
- The correct method of mounting grinder discs
- The correct use and positioning of guards

All personnel who use potentially dangerous equipment in the form of Power Tools
